

Investor Awareness – NSDL & CDSL Mobile Applications (SPEED-e & MyEasi)

Pursuant to the circular issued by the Exchanges and Depositories in regard to Mobile Applications by Depositories for Investors, and as part of our ongoing investor awareness initiatives, we would like to inform you that NSDL and CDSL, in coordination with SEBI, have strengthened their investor mobile applications to enhance transparency, accessibility, and real-time access to securities-related information.

Investors holding Demat accounts with either depository can access their holdings, transactions, and related information through the respective mobile applications:

- NSDL – SPEED-e App
- CDSL – MyEasi App

Key Features (Applicable to Both Applications):

1. Consolidated view of securities of client across both the Depositories eliminating the need for multiple login.
2. Transaction and holding statements at one place improving portfolio management by investors.
3. Monitoring of open positions and margin details across Stock Exchanges and Clearing Corporations.
4. Option to exercise E-voting on company resolutions; and
5. Access to recommendations of proxy advisers on resolutions.
